

VILLAGE OF GILMAN
PROCLAMATION
LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

Whereas, the 2019 novel coronavirus (COVID-19) is a contagious, and at times fatal, respiratory disease; the worldwide outbreak of COVID-19 and the effects of its extreme risk of person-to-person transmission throughout the United States significantly affect the lives and health, security, and safety of the public; and

Whereas, on or about March 12, 2020, the State of Wisconsin and the federal government declared a State of Emergency, due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

Whereas, the COVID-19 Pandemic has impacted, or is expected to impact the Village of Gilman; and

Whereas, on March 12, 2020, governor of the State of Wisconsin through Executive order #72 declared a State of Emergency in response to COVID-19; and

Whereas, on March 13, 2020, President of the United States declared a national emergency with respect to the COVID 19 outbreak; and

Whereas, COVID-19 has or is expected to impact the Village of Gilman; and

Whereas, emergency conditions exist and the Village Board of the Village of Gilman is unable to meet promptly; and

Whereas, pursuant to Wis. Stats. 323.11 and 323.14(4)(b), it is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare and good order of the Village of Gilman to extend, commit and exhaust its pertinent available resources; and

Whereas, the Village of Gilman requests State and Federal assistance and advises the State of Wisconsin of its emergency conditions.

NOW THEREFORS, PURSUANT TO Wis. Stats. 323.11 and 323.14(4)(b), as Village President and Chief Executive Officer of the Village of Gilman, I hereby:

1. Proclaim that a public health state of emergency exists in the Village of Gilman.
2. Authorize the emergency purchase of goods and materials; and

3. Authorize emergency purchases of services; and
4. Authorize the closure or other appropriate limitations related to access by the public in all Village buildings; and
5. Authorize the Village Clerk to assist and take all appropriate measures related to Village employees in addressing and responding to this state of emergency; and
6. The proclamation shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of existing monies for such purposes.

This Proclamation shall take effect immediately and shall continue in effect until further notice, or such time as a quorum of the Village Board convenes.
