YARD WASTE SITE TO OPEN

The yard waste site will be open starting in May 2014. This yard waste site is for the convenience of Village residents. No appliances or nails or screws in any of the wood. <u>Misuse of the site may result in monitoring of the site or even permanent closure of the site</u>. Please call the Public Works Building if you have questions on this matter.

BRUSH PILES-Brush Piles cannot accumulate on lawns. You need to take your brush piles/branches to the brush dump site.

HYDRANT FLUSHING

The Public Works Department will be flushing hydrants in May. The time of flushing will be between the hours of 8a.m. and 4:00p.m. Monday through Friday. The flushing of the hydrants opens the hydrants and cleans out the chemical and mineral deposits in the water mains and insures that each hydrant is functioning properly for fire protection purposes. If water is drawn into the house or business plumbing during, or soon after hydrants in the area have been opened, it may include dislodged materials and look discolored. It is not harmful but could cause laundry stains. If such discolored water is drawn into the property, it can be cleared by opening the water taps nearest the water meter to full flow until the water runs clear. If you have any special situations that might be affected by water main flushing or questions, please contact the Public Works Department.

If you fail to clean the sidewalk, the Village will clean the sidewalk at the homeowner's/businesses expense.

CROSS CONNECTION

The Village is mandated to have inspections of all village residences and businesses for cross connections. Romig's Hardware will be doing the Residential inspections. The Village is paying for the initial inspection this time. If you do not allow this inspection we will follow the procedures from the DNR on disconnection and that you may be charged for the inspection. Please call the Public Works office for more information.

SEWER/WATER DISCONNECTIONS AND RECONNECTIONS CHARGES

There is a \$30.00 reconnection charge for turning your water back on and a \$40.00 charge after normal business hours.

SEWER-

<u>DO NOT</u> flush paper towels, gloves, napkins, tampons, diapers, pads, etc into the sewer system as this causes the system to back up and may back up into your own basement and cause damage to the system. Sewer Use Ordinance ~ **SECTION 5.**<u>PROTECTION FROM DAMAGE ~</u>No person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently break, damage, destroy, uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure, appurtenance, or equipment which is a part of the wastewater collection and treatment system. Any person violating this provision shall be subject to immediate arrest under the charge of disorderly conduct.

APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE IN THE VILLAGE CLERK'S OFFICE

The Village Clerk's Office administers many applications for the Village Board. Applications that you can procure through the Village Clerk's Office are as follows:

<u>Park Applications</u> – This is to reserve the park for private parties, family reunions, ball games, etc. There are park applications in the clerk's office-\$50 deposit per day.

<u>Building Permits</u> – This is for any new buildings and remodeling done over \$2000 in value. Roofing does not require a building permit if the structure of the roof is unchanged. These permits are \$25.00 for the permit and \$1.00 for each \$10,000 worth of work for residential and \$50.00 for permit and \$5.00 for each \$10,000 worth of work for commercial.

<u>CDBG Loan Application</u> – Come into the Clerk's Office for more information and an application for a NO Interest Loan for remodeling of your home.

<u>Voter Registration</u> - This application is required for all new electors who move into the Village or have changed their name or their address since the last election. A change in residency form will be sent to the former municipality.

<u>Absentee Ballot Requests</u> – This would be requested if an elector was unable to come to the Municipal Building on Election Day but still wanted to vote.
