ACH for Water/Sewer Bills

You can now sign up for ACH payments for your water and sewer billings. You can pay monthly or quarterly as needed. Stop by the office to fill out the form or email treasurer@gilmanwi.com. YARD WASTE SITE

Misuse of the site has resulted in monitoring of the site and if continues then Permanent Closure of the site will be the only alternative. The yard waste site is open for the convenience of Village residents for Brush, Twigs, Leaves, and Grass Clippings ONLY. **No Mattresses, Appliances, furniture, etc.** Please call the Public Works Building if you have questions 715-447-8520.

BRUSH PILES-Brush Piles **cannot** accumulate on lawns. Need to take your brush piles/branches to the brush site. ONLY BRUSH, TWIGS, LEAVES, and GRASS CLIPPINGS go to the site. NO OTHER WOOD such as cupboards, tables, etc.! You need to dispose of this with GFL or when we have roll off bins!

Please remember everyone needs to maintain their lawns.

GRASS CLIPPINGS: KEEP grass clippings off the Village Streets. A concern is that grass clippings will enter our sewer mains and cause issues.

HYDRANT FLUSHING

The Public Works Department will be flushing hydrants the last week of JUNE -1st part of July! The time of flushing will be between the hours of 7a.m. and 4:00p.m. Monday through Friday. The flushing of the hydrants opens the hydrants and cleans out the chemical and mineral deposits in the water mains and insures that each hydrant is functioning properly for fire protection purposes. If water is drawn into the house or business plumbing during, or soon after hydrants in the area have been opened, it may include dislodged materials and look discolored. It is not harmful but could cause laundry stains. If such discolored water is drawn into the property, it can be cleared by opening the water taps nearest the water meter to full flow until the water runs clear. If you have any special situations that might be affected by water main flushing or questions, please contact the Public Works Department 715-447-8520.

DO NOT FLUSH WIPES, paper towels, Kleenex, gloves, napkins, tampons, diapers, pads, etc into the sewer system as this causes the system to back up and may back up into your own basement and cause damage to the system. Sewer Use Ordinance ~ **SECTION 5.**

PROTECTION FROM DAMAGE ~No person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently break, damage, destroy, uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure, appurtenance, or equipment which is a part of

the wastewater collection and treatment system. Any person violating this provision shall be subject to immediate arrest under the charge of disorderly conduct.

APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE IN THE VILLAGE CLERK’S OFFICE

The Village Clerk’s Office administers many applications for the Village Board. Applications that you can procure through the Village Clerk’s Office are as follows:

Park Applications – This is to reserve the park for private parties, family reunions, ball games, etc. There are park applications in the clerk’s office- \$50 deposit per day.

Building Permits – This is for any new buildings and remodeling done over \$2000 in value. Roofing does not require a building permit if the structure of the roof is unchanged. These permits are \$30.00 for the permit and \$2.00 for each \$10,000 worth of work for residential and \$75.00 for permit and \$5.00 for each \$10,000 worth of work for commercial.
